Nature Trail - Ben Mummert

Brad asked Ben to let us know to expect a letter regarding data center ordinance review.

- Bridge maintenance We had a volunteer who did Superstructure staining, Construction mat infill, tree removal, and trimming (not completed – Letort Park bridge; rust repair, abutment palling, footer scour)
- Trail vegetation management and planting schedule.
- I-81 Bridge graffiti no new graffiti reported.
- Mowing needed on grass shoulders along the trail
 - Ben requested that we <u>not</u> ask SMT to do the mowing due to experience where they spread creeping thistle and other nasty invasives.
 - Spraying schedule for the future.
- Drainage along South Spring Garden Street
 - Andy met with SMT regarding drainage on Spring Garden Street. They are aware of this issue.
 - The contractor had last year had done some extensive spraying that was not approved resulting in bank erosion sending sediment along the stream. The contractor will now mow instead of spraying.
 - Discussed the possibility of SMT installing a cross drain (need to coordinate with CPC). They have a swale that runs down between Spring Garden Street and their new parking lot and their new ADA accessible trail. Proposing installing an inlet up near the intersection Bonnybrook and taking at least some of the water and crossing it over into the swale on the CPC property. SMT will investigate it.
 - Also discussed where the swale is crossing the trail and causing trail washout, putting either a pipe or drop inlet under the trail to control waterflow. SMT will investigate whether there is enough elevation.
 - o Bonnybrook Road pipes will be cleaned out.
- Trash bags being left along the trail
